Such remedial care includes, but is not limited to, X-ray examination, anesthetic, medical and surgical diagnosis and treatment, psychological and psychiatric diagnosis and counseling, and hospital care to be rendered to the Minor upon advice of, and under the general or special supervision of, a licensed physician and surgeon, a licensed psychologist and psychiatrist, or a licensed dentist.
