ORDER: CONFLICT CRIMINAL
DEFENDERS' (CCD) APPOINTMENT IN
CASES WHERE THE PUBLIC DEFENDER
DECLARES AN OVERLOAD

Effective immediately, in any case in which the Public Defender declines to accept appointment due to overload, pursuant to its authority under Penal Code section 987.2, the Court shall appoint an attorney from the Indigent Defense Panel (IDP). Unless otherwise ordered, by acceptance of the appointment, counsel shall be paid according to the IDP fee schedule in effect at the time of appointment and will be subject to all terms applicable to IDP appointed counsel under the "Attorney Agreement for Legal Services through Conflict Criminal Defenders."

The Conflict Criminal Defenders' (CCD) Office is hereby appointed to implement these appointments, by selecting the attorney from the IDP and performing the administrative functions CCD previously performed under its Memorandum of Understanding with the Sacramento County Bar Association.

This order shall supersede all previous orders by the Court regarding these matters and shall remain in effect until such time as it may be modified or revoked. This order does not prevent the appointment of counsel from other than the IDP where otherwise appropriate in individual cases.
